With reference to your submission received on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2023, to carry out the repair or refurbishment of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment under waste exemption T11 of the above Regulations at the above site.

We can confirm that the operation has been registered as exempt.

The exemption will remain valid at this site until **17<sup>th</sup> January 2027**. We will remind you that the exemption is due for renewal eight weeks prior to this date. If you wish to continue to benefit from a T11 exemption after this date you will need to renew your registration.

Although the above operation is now registered it remains so only whilst you operate within the terms and conditions of the exemption and whilst you do not cause pollution, harm to the human health or detriment to amenity. It is a criminal offence to carry out this type of operation without an exemption or environmental permit. It is your responsibility to ensure that you know what the legislation requires and that you operate within it.
